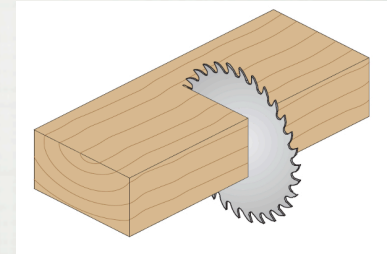


WORDS OF THE DAY

CROSSCUTTING is when you cut a board across the grain (at a right angle to the direction of the grain). This process changes the length of the board.



RIPPING is when you cut a board with the grain (parallel to the wood grain). This process changes the width of the board.
