## Video Production Process

- 1. Brainstorm/Outline
  - a. Get your ideas on paper
- 2. Pitch
  - a. Get feedback from your classmates to improve your ideas
  - b. The process in which you try to sell your idea(s) to others in hope to get the green light
- 3. Storyboard
  - a. Who, Where, What, Type of shot, Type of Audio
- 4. Film
  - a. Capture your clips
- 5. Edit
  - a. Import Clips
  - b. Edit in iMovie
- 6. Present
  - a. Export to a video file
  - b. Show your audience

<u>Equipment</u>

- <u>Tripod</u>- A 3 legged stand use to obtain a steady shot
- <u>Wheels</u>- Used along with a tripod to capture footage that require camera movement.
- <u>Camera/SD Card</u>- Used to capture your clips
- <u>Computer</u>- Used to edit the video using iMovie

<u>Terms</u>

- <u>Head/Tail Room</u>- Refers to the recorded space you leave at the beginning and end of your clip.
- <u>Ducking</u>-Used to decrease the volume of a track (audio) outside of your video clip. (Volume of the outside track will decrease when the clip starts and will then increase when the clip is over)
